The City of Loudon is seeking a highly motivated and qualified **Operator** in the Parks and Recreation Department. This position which reports directly to the Director of Facilities and Maintenance will be responsible for maintaining all facilities in the Parks and Recreation system.

Responsibilities include:

- Operate all equipment to maintain parks (i.e. tractors, backhoes, mowers, bucket trucks, etc).
- Perform all carpentry, masonry, electrical, plumbing, painting, and HVAC, etc. as necessary
- Schedule the work of Parks and Rec Laborers to maximize efficiency
- Understand that the duties listed above are intended only as illustrations of the various types of work that may be performed. The omission of specific statement of duties does not exclude them from the position if the work is similar, related or a logical assignment to the position.

Physical demands:

- Frequently lift and carry up to 50 lbs.
- Frequently stand and or walk to pick up trash
- Frequently work from a seated position for extended periods
- Stoop, kneel, crouch, bend, twist, crawl, etc. as necessary to perform maintenance tasks
- Ability to work with hands extended in front or overhead to use tools or operate vehicles and to work from ladders (painting, hanging lights, etc.)
- Occasional exposure to: inclement weather, high noise, paints, solvents, and cleaning supplies. Exposure to Chlorine for pool maintenance

The ideal candidate for this position will possess a High School Diploma or G.E.D. Possession of a valid Tennessee CDL Class A driver's license at start of employment is preferred; commitment to successfully obtaining CDL licensure within 6 months of employment will also be considered. The ideal candidate will have sufficient communication skills to coordinate with staff, customers, and contractors on the phone and in person. The ideal candidate must also possess sufficient visual and reading acuity to comprehend printed materials and interpret written instructions and directions as well as adequate mathematical ability. The City of Loudon desires an energetic individual with a passion for excellent performance that can work well with coworkers and members of the public in a professional and courteous manner.
