# **GARBAGE PICKUP**

- 17-101. <u>Materials the town will not pick up</u>. The Town of Englewood will pick up residential garbage once per week for all residents in the town. Garbage must be placed on the curb of the street. The town will only accept household garbage. Containers must not exceed thirty-five (35) gallons with a limit of two (2) containers only. (2008 Code, § 17-101)
- **17-102.** <u>Residential garbage</u>. The Town of Englewood will pick up residential garbage once per week for all residents in the town. Garbage must be placed on the curb of the street. Containers must not exceed thirty-five (35) gallons. (2008 Code, § 17-102)
- 17-103. <u>Business garbage</u>. The town will pick up the garbage of all businesses within the town twice per week. (2008 Code, § 17-103)
- 17-104. <u>Premises to be kept clean</u>. All persons within the town are required to keep their premises in a clean and sanitary condition, free from accumulations of refuse except when stored as provided in this chapter. (2008 Code, § 17-104)

- 17-105. Storage. Each owner, occupant, or other responsible person using or occupying any building or other premises within the town where refuse accumulates, or is likely to accumulate, shall provide and keep covered an adequate number of refuse containers. The refuse containers shall be strong, durable, and rodent and insect proof. They shall each have a capacity of not less than twenty (20) nor more than thirty-five (35) gallons. No refuse shall be placed in a refuse container until such refuse has been drained of all free liquids. Tree trimmings, hedge clippings, and similar materials shall be cut to a length not to exceed four feet (4') and shall be securely tied in individual bundles weighing not more than seventy-five (75) pounds each and being not more than two feet (2') thick before being deposited for collection. - 17-106. <u>Garbage rates</u>. Garbage rates for residential garbage service and business garbage service that does not exceed the definition of residential service, as defined in § 17-101 of this chapter, shall be seven dollars and fifty cents (\$7.50) per month for residential household or qualifying business. (Ord. #103, Oct. 2017)
- 17-107. <u>Violations and penalty</u>. Violations of this chapter shall be punishable under the general penalty provision of this code. Each day a violation is allowed to continue shall constitute a separate offense. (2008 Code, § 17-107)
