A RESOLUTION REQUESTING REPRESENTATIVE FRANK BUCK AND SENATOR CHARLOTTE BURKS TO INTRODUCE LEGISLATION IN THE TENNESSEE GENERAL ASSEMBLY AMENDING THE CHARTER OF THE CITY OF SMITHVILLE
