In addition to ASE requirements, Technicians are required to pass the F1 & F2 exams, Technician Ils are required to have F1 – F4 and Masters are required to have F1 – F6. All Fire Apparatus Technicians are granted a 15% differential pay on top of their base salary for working in the Fire Shop. They also receive "On-Call pay" which
