1. SCOPE

The Town of Collierville is seeking bids for a new four-wheel drive front-end loader for use by the Town's Public Works Department.

2. QUALIFICATIONS OF BIDDER

All bidders must be financially stable and experienced and the Town will, among other things, consider such factors in determining to whom the bid shall be awarded.

Bids will only be accepted from established manufacturers or their authorized dealers. In the event a dealer submits a bid, the dealer shall guarantee that he/she is an authorized dealer of the manufacturer and the manufacturer has agreed to supply the dealer with the equipment offered in the proposal. Further, the dealer agrees to submit a certificate from the manufacturer acknowledging that he/she is an authorized dealer, if so requested.

3. PRICING

Price proposed shall exclude all taxes which are not applicable to Town purchases.

4. DELIVERY

All items shall be delivered F.O.B. destination with delivery costs and charges included in the bid unless otherwise stated in the specifications or proposal. The term F.O.B. Destination shall mean delivered and unloaded with all charges for transportation and unloading paid by the vendor.

If any questions or responses require revisions to the solicitation as originally published, such revisions will be by formal amendment only. If the solicitation includes a separate contact for technical information, bidders are cautioned that any written or oral representations made by any Town representative or other person that appear to change materially, conflict with, or modify any portion of the solicitation shall not be relied upon unless subsequently ratified by a written amendment to this solicitation issued by the Town. 6. SUBMISSION OF BID DOCUMENTS

The Bid, with attachments, must be placed in the supplied Town of Collierville bid envelope, sealed and delivered to the Town of Collierville. The envelope containing the Bid and attachments must be plainly marked with the following information to-wit:

One (1) set of complete descriptive literature shall be furnished with bid. (Failure to provide appropriate information SHALL be just cause for rejection of the bid.)

7. SPECIFICATIONS

7.1. Operating Weight

Any manufacturers' names, trade names, brand names, or catalog numbers used in the specifications are there for the purpose of establishing and describing general performance and quality levels. Such references are not intended to be restrictive, and bids are invited on these and comparable brands or products of any manufacturer, which meets or exceeds the quality of the specifications listed for any item unless otherwise stated in the specifications or proposal.

A bidder may offer only one (1) price on each item though they may have 2 or more types that meet specifications. Bidder must determine for themselves which to offer. Submission by a single bidder of more than one (1) price for a single item shall be sufficient cause for rejection of all prices for that item by the bidder.

Loader, bidder hereby understands and mutually agrees to the terms of this section.

If the successful bidder fails to deliver the Four-Wheel Drive Front-End Loader within the time specified in their bid, the actual damages to the Town for the delay will be difficult or impossible to determine. The Town will deduct \$50.00 as fixed amount as liquidated damages for each calendar day of delay, the amount of \$50.00 per calendar day for said items not received per the delivery schedule set forth within the bid documents. The acceptance of awarded purchase order will serve as a binding contract including all bid documents for this provision.

The bidder shall not be charged with liquidated damages or any excess cost when the Town determines that the bidder is without fault and the bidders reasons for the time extension are acceptable to the Town; provided, further, that the bidder shall not be charged with liquidated damages or any excess cost when delay is due to unforeseeable cause beyond the control and without the fault or negligence of the bidder.

Provided, however, that the bidder shall, within ten (10) days from the delivery date notify the Town,
in writing, of the causes of the delay, who shall ascertain the facts and extant of the delay and notify
the bidder within a reasonable time of its decision in the matter.
