ORDINANCE NO.	

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF MOUNTAIN CITY, TENNESSEE ESTABLISHING PROCEDURES AND REQUIREMENTS FOR THE CARRYING OF PAGERS OR OTHER ELECTRONIC COMMUNICATIONS DEVICES.

WHEREAS, the ability to contact Town employees during off-duty hours is extremely important in case of emergency, and;

WHEREAS, electronic pagers and similar devices provide a technology which allows employees to go about their business during off-duty hours while maintaining contact with the Town in the event of an emergency;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN OF MOUNTAIN CITY, TENNESSEE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Town of Mountain City Municipal Code is hereby amended by adding a new section to Title 4, Chapter 2 as follows:

4-210. <u>Pagers and other electronic communications devices</u>. Certain employees may be required to carry a pager or other electronic communications device during off-duty hours. Such employees shall make a reasonable effort to respond to pages or other communications as quickly as possible.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage, the welfare of the Town requiring it.
